

# Mornington Golf Club: Ladies 2018 Programme

## Daily competition

Before Teeing off a few logistics to ensure you are registered for the daily and season events

- \$3 – covers the day's competition, closest to the pins and registers you for the hole in one
  - add your name to the starters sheet, if you aren't already listed
  - add your name on the day's competition sheet, pay your \$3 into the envelope and tick paid next to your name on the sheet
  
- Your card
  - Check the whiteboard for the day's events – there will usually be two – 1) the season trophy event and 2) the daily competition
  - Record the event(s) you are playing in on your card
  - Check your index and course handicap off the laminated sheet (different sheets depending on if you are playing 9 or 18 holes)
  - After your round ensure your card is signed and you and your playing partner both have the same scores for your round
  - Record any birdies on the Birdie Tree and advise Debbie or whomever is coordinating for the day (partner to initial sheet to validate birdie)
  - Record any 1, or less, putts on the Putting sheet (partner initial sheet to validate score)
  - Hand your card into Debbie whomever is coordinating the day
  
- Competition is based on the official 9 holes (unless it is a scheduled 18-hole event). It's no problem if you play more holes however you will need to calculate and record the official 9 hole result on your card
  
- Prize pool for the daily competition
  - Winner 2 vouchers and second place one voucher
  - Closest to the pins
    - # 11 – closest to the PIN
      - does not need to be on the green unless your handicap is 18 or less
      - 2 golf balls
    - # 12 – closest to the PIN in two
      - does not need to be on the green unless your handicap is 18 or less
      - 2 golf balls
    - # 18 – closest to the PIN
      - must be on the green and will be played for on the days Ladies full field play 18 holes. This will be a money hole and if no player hits the green it will jackpot to the next 18-hole day
    - **Birdies**– 3 Clyde's birdie balls (while Clyde still sponsors us)
    - # 6 – closest to the PIN
      - Joint mens & ladies and MUST be on the Green

## Trophies

- **PAMELA Cup** – best season opening nett round
- **VON WATSON Trophy** – over two rounds -best combined putting and nett
- **DONOVAN Rose Bowl** – single round - best nett par 4's
- **I SIMPSON Cup** - over 3 rounds– 1 each of putting/ nett and stableford
- **ANDREWS Plate** –single round, pairs, best ball stableford
- **GEORGE Trophy** - Putting, best 4 scores over the season
- **DENTICE Cup / LGU days**– Nett, best 4 scores over the season
- **LAWSON Cup** - Stableford, best 4 scores over the season
- **MORNINGTON Trophy (new)** – Putter of the season, most 1 or less putts
- **M YOUNG Trophy (new)** – 18-hole stableford, best 3 scores over the season
- **MORGAN Cup** -pairs best ball stableford, single round
- **F SMITH Cup (new)** – 18 holes pairs, best ball stableford
- **LGU medal** –Bronze division - aggregate of four best nett rounds played over March, April & May (max. handicap index 40.4)
- **CHAMPIONSHIP Cup** – matchplay
- **FINN Cup** – Eclectics – the lowest score on each of the official 9 holes
  - To be eligible you need a max. score of a double bogey on each hole
  - **JOKER BONUS:** depending on your handicap you get to play 1 or 2 jokers. The joker allows you to select one hole and either give yourself a double bogey to be eligible for the Cup, or if you have already score doubles or better you can use the joker to reduce one hole by one shot
  - Handicap jokers
    - 18 or under – no joker
    - 19 -36 – 1 joker
    - 36+ - 2 jokers
  - To use your joker, you need to let Debbie know prior to the close off date (May & Nov), it will not be automatically applied
  - The total score is subject to the deduction of quarter of your 9-hole handicap. Eclectics will be played for twice – Dec-May & June – Nov
- **KENNETH HEMI Memorial Trophy - Top Cat** – 9 or 18-hole qualifying round, partners then selected and knock out pairs matchplay rounds
  - **BRIAN FRANK Cup** – Top Cat – top qualifier - nett
- **D POLLOCK Plate**- Most Improved player over the season
- **Birdie Tree** – no trophy, just the honour of the best and most birdie dances. Birdie tree is in play all year so nail those birdies and write them up!!

## Ladies Golf Union (LGU)

This season we will again try to incorporate LGU events into our calendar. The Home Links Events are played over 18 holes (so should LGU but only playing Sunday's makes this extremely difficult so will be over 9 holes). Max LGU handicap index 40.4.

- **LGU medal** –Bronze division - a medal is awarded to the player with the lowest aggregate of four best nett rounds. The Club must have a min. of six and a max. of 16 LGU medal competitions programmed
- **Home Links Events** – these events are played at club courses throughout the country with District and National winners being determined from individual club results – i.e. there is no play off level. Events must be played during the months of March, April and May
  - **Nancy McCormick Foursomes** – a foursomes (alternative shots) handicap strokeplay played over two rounds. A pairs net score for each 18 holes is determined by deducting half your combined course handicap (no rounding). The winning pairs nett score is submitted to Wgtn Golf
  - **Individual events played concurrently**
    - **Coronation Medal** – Silver division, 18-hole handicap stroke play
    - **Aotearoa Cup** – Silver & bronze division, 18-hole handicap stroke play
    - **Best Gross Cup** – open to all divisions, 18-hole gross stroke play

### **Game definitions**

*for games where a countback cannot be used to determine the outright winner (in cases of a tie in score) the winner will be determined by a random selection from the tied players cards*

#### ***Goat Trackers Twist***

A Mornington spin on scoring for nett, putting and or stableford

#### ***Par***

Scored hole by hole –play to your handicap and score 0, play under handicap to score +1, play over handicap to score -1 point. Winner is the player with the most points

#### ***Closest for the Mostest***

After everyone gets on the green and regardless of the number of strokes, the player closest to the hole gets 3 points, the next player closest to the hole gets 2 points, the next player closest to the hole gets 1 point and the player farthest from the hole gets 0 points. Winner is the player with the highest number of points

#### ***BossLady***

The player with the lowest score on each hole becomes the BossLady on the following hole. If two players tie then the current Bosslady continues for the next hole. The winner is the player who has been the BossLady on the most number of holes.

#### ***Fourball-Best Ball***

Teams of two – each play their own ball and take the best score for the team.

#### ***Skins***

Each hole is worth 1 skin. Win the hole a get the SKIN point. If no-one wins the hole the SKIN is carried over so the next hole is worth 2 SKINS and so on until a hole is won. Winner is the player with the most SKINS.

#### ***Split Sixes***

6 points is up for grabs at each hole. If a player wins the hole outright they get 4 points, second 2 points and remaining players in group zero points. If one player wins the hole and two tie for second the points would allocate 4/1/1/0. If two players tie the hole for the win points awarded 3/3/0/0...so only ever 6 points awarded for each hole. Winner is the player with the most points.

#### ***Stablefords on Steroids***

Each set of 3 holes is multiplied by an increasing factor then added together for the total

Holes 1,2,3      stablefords scored X 1

Holes 4,8,9      stablefords scored X 2

Holes 10,11,12   stablefords scored x 3



### ***Mornington Shuffle***

The stableford score on an even numbered hole is multiplied with the score on the previous odd numbered hole ...example of how to score
